ABSTRACT

On January 11, 2018, Hancock Health, a small health system located in an eastern suburb of Indianapolis, was attacked by cybercriminals from eastern Europe. Health system leaders teamed with attorneys from Hall Render and cyber security specialists from Pondurance to respond to the attack and rapidly restore system functionality.
